

## League Rules:

- Team rosters due by Monday before first game.
  - 20 man Maximum roster including two managers.
- Game time max three and half hours (3 ½) or nine (9) innings.
- There will be wood divisions and aluminum.
  - Aluminum bat cannot be less than -3 and barrels can only be 2 5/8.
  - Players using other bats will be expelled from game.
  - Fined \$100 before next game.
  - Team will forfeit the game.
- KO 15 runs after five innings, 10 after seven complete innings.
  - (Except Championship)
- Each team is responsible umpire fee (\$65) per game two umpires (\$50) for one.
- DH is only for the Pitcher
- Each player has to be in uniformed (hat, shirt, pants, athletic shoes).
- Batters and runners must wear helmets at all times.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed during the game.
  - No player shall be allowed to participate if he's suspected of being under the influence of alcohol.
- No player shall be allowed to use inappropriate language towards the umpire or another player. If this happens the umpire might issue a warning, if the player continues player shall be ejected. (Player will be disciplined by the league)
- Violence shall not be tolerated by the league, a player showing an act of violence towards an official, another player, or other participants will be fined and disciplined by the league according to incident.
- Each player is required to have proper identification with him. Proper ids include:
  - Drivers license
  - Birth Certificate
  - Passport
  - Id from their state or country
- Protest: Any manager can ask for another player to identify himself if there's doubt of identity.
- Protested Games:
  - Any protest has to be presented to the leagues board of directors.
  - There are only two reasons a game can be protested.
    - Illegal player
    - Rule misinterpreted by an umpire.
  - Protests have to be made before the following game.
  - Protests have to be signed by umpires and reason why game is being protested.
  - Circumstances
    - Pitcher, Batter, Count, Outs, Bases occupied by whom, Score.

- Homeplate umpire has to sign score book
  - \$50 dollar fee per protest. (Win money returns if you lose money don't return.)
- There will be a grace period to pick up or release extra players. To release a player you will have to notify the league. To pick an extra player after (three games) each player will have to pay a \$50 fee to the league before he is allowed to play. Rosters cannot exceed more than 20 players at any time.
- A team may be allowed to start a game with 8 players to avoid forfeits.
  - When it's the ninth batter he will be declared out.
  - By the fifth inning your team must have nine players. If not it will be declared a forfeit.
- If an umpire suspects a pitcher is throwing intentionally at a batter, he will be warned. If this continues, the umpire will eject the pitcher. Pitcher will have to sit out a game and be fined \$50 before returning to play.
- No fake tags allowed. If umpire sees it runner will be awarded an extra base. If the same player does it again he will be ejected from the game.
- Each player must try to avoid physical contact with another player (especially home). Umpire will decide if contact is accidental or deliberate. If umpire decides contact was intentional, player will be ejected and disciplined by the league.
- Suspensions: A suspension during regular season or post season will be declared the same.
  - If a player is suspended during the last game of the season (with team in playoffs). He will have to serve his suspension during playoffs.
  - First ejection-One game suspension and \$50.00 dollar fine
  - Second ejection-Three game suspension and \$100.00 fine
  - Third ejection-Suspension for rest of the season or 12 games (depending on incident) and \$150.00 fine.
    - All fines and games served have to be met before returning to play.
- Forfeits-Losing team is responsible for both umpire fees.
  - If losing team cannot afford it winning team may pay one umpire fee. Winning team will be reimbursed by the league. Losing team will be responsible for other umpire fee before playing next game.
- Standings are as the following:
  - Games won- (2) two points
  - Games tied- (1) one point
- All other rules are Major League Rules
